

Project CROOS 2011 In-season Report Time Periods 1 - 4, May 15 – July 15, 2011

Period 1-4 Sample Statistics

Number hours fished	2486.9
Number legal-sized fish landed	1799
Fish caught per hour effort (CPUE)	0.72
Number legal-sized fish sampled	1708
Number of fish genotyped	1530
Percent of fish genotyped	95%

To the right, aggregate catch is shown for time periods 1-4. From May 15 to July 15, 2011, the average catch per hour (0.72) increased from May to July last year (0.57). Note the scale for "catch per square nautical mile" changed from previous report.





Shown to the left, effort, catch and genetic stock identification results are combined to generate "catch per hour per stock" estimates.

In Periods 1-4, Mid Oregon Coast, Central Valley fall run and Upper Columbia summer/fall runs dominated the harvest.

From July 1 - 10, only 22 fish were sampled coast-wide, therefore we are not presenting an individual Period 4 report.
